

ACE Dementia Programme

Course Content - Level 4 programme containing 4 unit standards and 20 credits

Module 1 – An Overview of Dementia contains unit standard

23920 (Element 1) – Demonstrate knowledge of dementia, person-centred care and communication for a person living with dementia

Module 2 – Person-centred Care contains unit standard

23920 (Element 2 & 3) – Demonstrate knowledge of dementia, person-centred care and communication for a person living with dementia

Module 3 – Provide Person-centred Care contains unit standards

23921 – Provide person-centred care when supporting a person living with dementia

Includes: General guidelines for care, adapting to the person's changing needs, communication, rights of the person with dementia, mobility, falls, personal care, activities...

Module 4 – Caring for Carers contains unit standard

23922 – Demonstrate knowledge of effects of dementia and how to manage them, for those caring for a person living with dementia

Module 5 – Behavioural Effects of Dementia contains unit standards

23923 (Element 1) – Demonstrate knowledge of support for people living with dementia when their behaviour presents challenges

Module 6 – Psychological Effects of Dementia

Includes: What are the psychological effects of dementia? What causes these psychological effects? Medication, key points for care, specific effects: delusions, hallucination, misidentifications, anxiety, mania.

Module 7 – Restraint Minimisation contains unit standard

23923 (Element 2) – Demonstrate knowledge of support for people living with dementia when their behaviour presents challenges.
